While furloughing in Switzerland Sunday, Sgt. Constantine Georgiadis telephoned his mother, Mrs. A. Georgiadis, 531 Tenth Ave., to wish her a happy Easter. He is stationed with the Second Special Service Company at Camp Philip Morris, France.

Sgt. Georgiadis entered the Army after his graduation from Liberty High School in 1944. He received basic infantry training at Camp Wolters, Tex., and trained with the Medical Corps at Camp Butner, N. C., before going overseas with the 355th Infantry Division 16 months ago. During his tour of duty in the European Theater, the sergeant was wounded twice and taken prisoner.

He served with Gen. Patton during the Rhine crossing last winter.

Sgt. Georgiadis has a brother, John, AM3/C, serving with the Navy in Anacostia, D. C.
