### Sgt. Mike Neiznay Awaits Redeployment

WITH U. S. FORCES, France -- First Sergeant Mike Neiznay, Heights Rural Station, veteran of seven years of Army service, 27 months of which were spent overseas in pre-Pearl Harbor days, is awaiting redeployment to the Pacific Operations Area at Calas Staging area with only 63 points.

Sgt. Neiznay has served in Europe for three months. His pre-war service is not considered under the Army point system for the redeployment of troops.

He entered the Army in 1938, was granted an honorable discharge in April, 1940, but reenlisted three months later. He served with the 71st Coast Artillery, the 21st Infantry Division, and the 384th Anti-Aircraft Artillery before being transferred to the European Theater of Operations with the 1474th Engineer Maintenance Company last April.

He is the husband of Mrs. Mary Neiznay Third Street, Bethlehem.
