Local War⁻ Prisoner Shot By Nazis

Mr. and Mrs. Theodore Stout, 1976 Easton Avenue, have been informed by the War Department that their son, Sgt. Richard Lee Stout, was killed in Belgium as of Jan. 7, 1945. Sgt. Stout had previously been reported missing in action during General Von Rundstedt's push in December.

A Bethlehem G-I who was a member of Stout's outfit, has informed Mr. and Mrs. Stout that their son had been captured and subsequently shot by the Germans.

A aduate of Moravian Prep, Sgt. Stout was employed by the metallurgical department of the Bethlehem Steel Company before entering the service Aug. 10, 1943. He had been serving overseas since August, 1944.

A memorial mass will be celebrated at 9:30 a. m., next Sunday, in St. Ann's Church.
