Pfc. Henry Byrnes, Nazareth, Reported Killed In France

According to a telegram from the War Department, Pfc. Henry H. Byrnes, son of Mrs. Ellen Byrnes, Nazareth, was killed in action in France November 15.

Pfc. Byrnes was stationed in Philadelphia with the Military Police after entering the service, later being transferred to the infantry, He was sent overseas in July, 1944 and was previously reported missing in action.

Prior to entering the service he was graduated from Nazareth High School with the class of 1940. A twin brother, John, is in the service, stationed at Cherry Point, N. C., A sister, Mrs. Lester Altemose of Nazareth, also survives.
