Three brothers from Nazareth serving in three branches of the armed forces are Staff Sergeant Vincent L. Master, U. S. Army Air Forces; Michael Master, B. M. 1-c, U. S. Navy, and Pfc. Humberto Master, U. S. M. C. Staff Sergeant Vincent Master entered the Army, July 8, 1941. He was promoted to private first class on May 1, 1942; to corporal August 16, 1942; to sergeant July 22, 1943, and to Staff Sergeant August 12, 1943. S-Sgt. Master was stationed at one of the South American air bases guarding the vital approaches to the Caribbean area for a period of two and a half years. He flew on daily patrols over an area extending from the western tip of Cuba to the sweltering

equatorial belt of South America. At the present time he is stationed at Atlantic City, N. J., after having completed a furlough at the home of his sister, Mrs. Thomas Reber, North Main Street, Nazareth. Michael Master, B. M. 1-c, U. S. Navy, enlisted on March 20, 1942. He is stationed at Boston, Mass., at the present time, as an instructor in a fire fighting school. Prior to his enlistment, he was Fire Chief in the Borough of Nazareth. Pfc. Humberto Master, U. S. M. C., received his basic training at Parris Island, S. C., having joined the Marines in September, 1942. He was stationed for a time at Camp Elliott, Cal., and is now serving somewhere overseas.
