Pfc. Torok Killed in Italy On April 16

Mrs. M. Torok of 520 Hayes Street, received word that her son, Pfc. Louis G. Torok, was killed in action in Italy on April 16. He served with the Fifth Army and had been overseas since October, 1944.

Pfc. Torok was inducted into the armed forces in November, 1942, and received his training at Fort San Houston and Camp Fannin, Tex. Prior to entering the service he was employed by Lehigh Valley Throwing Mills.

In addition to his mother, he is survived by one brother, Dennis, and four sisters, Mrs. Mary Vargo, Mrs. Frank Nemeth and Helen and Betty, both at home.
