**Pfc. Joseph Kulscar
Gets Army Discharge 1945**

Overseas with the 141st Infantry Regiment for two years, Pfc. Joseph Kulscar, son of Mrs. Anna Kulscar, R. 1, Riegelsville, was honorably discharged from the service yesterday at Indiantown Gap.

Inducted May 15, 1943, Pfc. Kulscar was employed as a lathe operator by the Bethlehem Steel Company. He holds the Good Conduct Medal, European, American Middle Eastern campaign ribbons with a bronze star and bronze arrowhead and the Purple Heart for wounds received in Italy January, 1944.
