

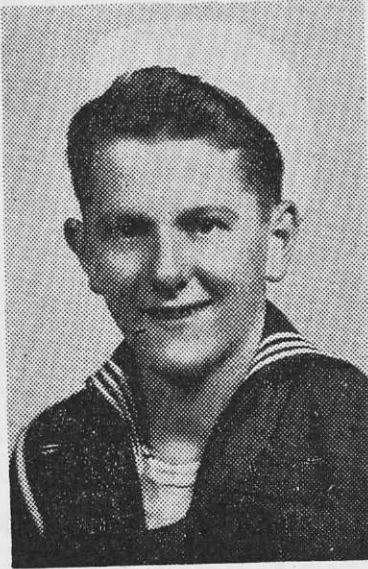

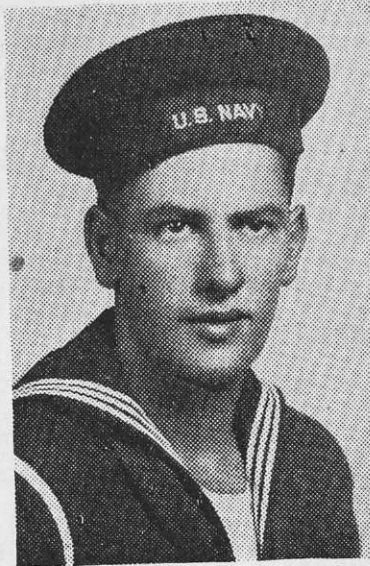
## Brothers in Navy, Promoted
