Capt. Meilicke entered the service in July, 1944 and received his basic training at Carlisle, Pa., Camp Ellis, Ill., and later at Fort Ord, Calif. At the present time he is stationed in the Philippines where he is connected with a Field Hospital. His main duty at the hospital is surgery in which field he specialized having taken graduate work in surgery at the University of Pennsylvania and two year surgical residency at the Presbyterian Hospital, Phila., before he entered the service.

The medical officer is a son of Mrs. C. A. Meilicke, Widows House, West Church Street, and the late Rev. C. A. Meilicke. While the captain is in service, his wife and young daughter will reside in Bangor.
