He will have served one year in the Navy the nineteenth of this month, five months of the year in active combat duty.

He took part in the invasion of Sicily and Italy, serving as Signal Communication operator on a Navy L. C. T. boat of the invasion fleet.

He attended Bethlehem Technical High School and received his boot training at Bainbridge, Md. Upon his graduation at the University of Chicago where he studied to be a Signal Code operator he was promoted to Petty Officer third class. He was then sent to Solomons, Md. for further specialized training, where on completion of studies he was sent overseas.
