## Nazareth Youth Wounded on African Front

MAY 17 1943

Private Charles P. Macy, 22, son of Mrs. Hazel M. Hilberg, 139 South Broad Street, Nazareth, was reported slightly wounded while serving with the U. S. Army in Africa on March 30. Two weeks ago Mrs. Hilberg received a telegram from the war department informing her of

her son's injury and later received a letter stating that her son had spent a month in a hospital recovering from his injuries.

The extent or nature of his injury was not given.

Private Macy enlisted in the U. S. Army December 26, 1940, and has been serving in Africa for the past eight months.
