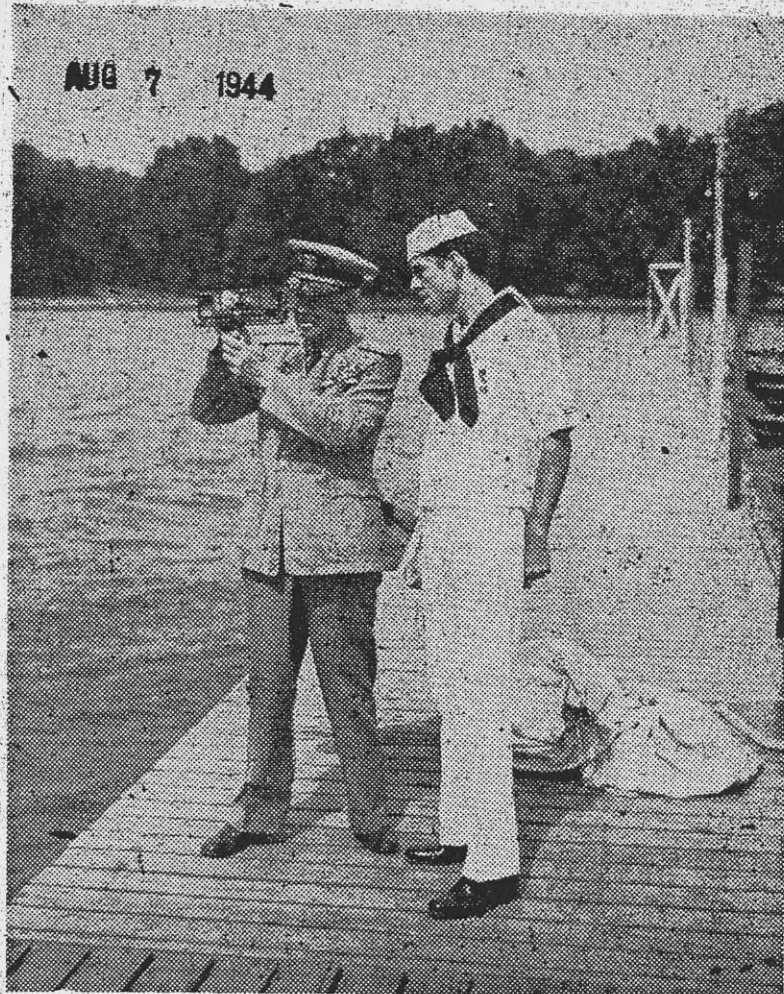


Kingsley, George P.
