#### TRAINING IN TEXAS

Training somewhere in Texas with the Army Air Force is Staff Sergeant Walter Zalower, a former member of the old 213th Regiment, Coast Artillery (AA). Sgt. Zalower enlisted with Battery C, Bethlehem unit in the First Defenders, and remained with the regiment for eight months, having been on the roster when the outfit was federalized by Presidential order.

In August of 1942 he transferred to the Air Force and was shipped to flexible gunnery school in Florida with the rating of sergeant. He was sent from there to Utah to study radio and upon graduation in January of this year was given the rating of staff sergeant. He was transferred first to California, where he was on the crew of a B-17 Bomber, and then to Texas.
