Lieut. C. W. Haltzman, Jr., piloted the Flying Fortress, "My Oklahoma Gal," from Apalachicola Army Air Base, Florida, to Middletown late Saturday with a full crew. He was able to spend a few hours with his parents, Mr. and Mrs. C. W. Haltzman, Sr., of Bethlehem R. D. 1.

"My Oklahoma Gal" was decorated with 203 bombs for the number of missions in the Pacific war theatre, five purple hearts, six Jap planes and the sinking of five ships. According to Lieut. Haltzman this Fortress is no longer in combat use and was turned over to the gunnery students at Apalachicola. He left at 2:30 p. m. yesterday for the Army Air Base at Apalachicola, Fla.
