**Pen Argyl R. D.
Soldier Killed
In French Action**

Pfc. Ralph-Jones Miller, 19-year-old son of Mrs. Elwood Wilson of Pen Argyl R. D. 1, living near Benders Church, was killed in action in France on June 17, according to information received in an official telegram from the War Department by Mrs. Wilson, Saturday afternoon.

He entered the U. S. Army in September, 1943, and last visited his mother on April 19 of this year. Since then he had gone overseas and into the French invasion. The last letter received by his mother was on June 15. Prior to entering the U. S. Army he was employed as a farmer.
