

Corporal Anthony De Crosta, reported missing in action since December 20, 1944, is now reported a prisoner of war in Germany, according to a card received by his sister, Lucy De Crosta, 538 Bradley Street. The card, written January 20, stated that he was in good health. Cpl. De Crosta entered the service in March, 1941, and completed his training at camps throughout the South before going overseas to England. He participated in the fighting in Luxembourg, Belgium and France.
