**Local Sailor Aboard
Returning Wisconsin**

James R. Janie, 22, seaman 1/C, 1017 Delaware Avenue, made the long voyage back to the States from Tokyo Bay with the 45,000-ton battleship, the USS Wisconsin, for her participation in the observance of Navy Day, October 27.

Based in San Francisco at present, Janie's ship figured prominently in the actions during the final eight months of the war, supporting Third Fleet operations in the Leyte and Luzon invasions, taking part in Fifth Fleet raids against Honshu and the Ryukyus in support of the Iwo Jima operations and making strikes with the Third Fleet against the home island of Tokyo.
