Pvt. Russell C. Ziegenfuss, son of Mrs. Ray Ziegenfuss, 1313 Altman Street, is spending a 30-day furlough with his mother.

Ziegenfuss enlisted in June, 1944, and received his basic training at Camp Wheeler, Ga. He was sent overseas last December and saw action in the battle of Saarbruecken with the 87th Division of the First Army, and in Luxembourg where he was wounded May 9. He was sent to a hospital in England and arrived in this country July 11. He will report to Indiantown Gap in August. A brother, Leon G. Ziegenfuss, is training at Camp Claiborne, La.
