Alfred Wolfe Commissioned In Air Forces

With his mother, Mrs. William D. Wolfe, 36 West Third Street, his sister, Mrs. Ray Frace and his son, Raymond, Jr., of Lancaster, present to witness the ceremonies, Alfred J. Wolfe, of this city on Tuesday was commissioned at Lubbock, Texas, as a lieutenant in the U. S. Army Air Corps.

Lieutenant Wolfe was graduated from Bethlehem Technical High School where he was active in athletics and the glee club; for 12 years was a member of the choir of the Pro-Cathedral Church of the Nativity.

He enlisted Oct. 30, 1942, in the Air Force and was stationed at Middletown, Ga., prior to being assigned to the University of Arkansas, later to San Antonio, Texas,

and finally to Lubbock.

He married Miss Alice Amigo, 1728 Madison Avenue, this city, on Easter Sunday, 1943.
