Mrs. Richard Andraschko, 945 Wyandotte Street, was informed in a letter from the Navy Department that her son, M. M. 3-c Anthony Andraschko, was wounded in action while in the service of his country. The telegram gave details of his injuries and stated that he had been strafed by an enemy plane. M. M. 3-c Andraschko was employed by the Bethlehem Steel Company prior to entering the service in August, 1942. He is a graduate of Holy Ghost Parochial School and of Bethlehem Technical High School.
