

IN THE MARIANAS — Robert B. Miller of Bethlehem, a 7th AAF fighter pilot who has been flying in combat against the Japs in the Western Pacific since last October, has been promoted to First Lieutenant.

Now a P-47 pilot, Lieutenant Miller won Air Medal Distinguished Flying Cross with tinguished Flying Cross with two Oak Leaf Clusters for par-ticipation in the first land-based fighter strikes against Truk and Iwo Jima as pilot of a 7th AAF P.38.
