IN THE MARIANAS — Robert B. Miller of Bethlehem, a 7th AAF fighter pilot who has been flying in combat against the Japs in the Western Pacific since last October, has been promoted to First Lieutenant.

Now a P-47 pilot, Lieutenant Miller won Air Medal Distinguished Flying Cross with two Oak Leaf Clusters for participation in the first land-based fighter strikes against Truk and Iwo Jima as pilot of a 7th AAF P.38.

His father, George F. Miller, lives at 1325 Montrose Avenue in Bethlehem. He was graduated from Lehigh University in 1942, and started cadet training in January, 1943.
