

With 28 years active duty in the U. S. Army behind him, M/Sgt. Kenneth S. Bauer, son of Mr. and Mrs. Cal Bauer, 731 Seventh Avenue, received an honorable retirement discharge from the U. S. Army at Indiantown Gap Military Reservation last Friday.
