Pvt. Knapp enlisted in the army June 30, 1942 and was sent to Fort Meade, Md. Having completed his basic training at Fort Belvoir, Va., he was sent to Camp Sheango, which was followed by overseas duty in Africa, Sardinia and Corsica.
