Private First Class George A. Dunbar, after spending a 30-day furlough with his uncle and aunt, Mr. and Mrs. Harry H. Brittenberg, 1062 Seneca Street, and his stepfather, George Miller, of Sioux Street, Fountain Hill, left Thursday afternoon on his return to the Naval Hospital, at Santiago, Calif.

Private Dunbar had received a bullet wound in his right shoulder in the battle at Guadalcanal last October and was then sent to a California hospital for treatment and recuperation.

On Thursday, his former associate employes of the Bethlehem Steel Company in the cold drawing and inspection section, donated a purse of \$45 for Dunbar, which Sterling H. Brittenberg, foreman, presented.
