WINS AIR MEDAL

An air medal has been awarded to Staff Sergeant Ray H. Baity, 21, home address 231 South Fourth Street, Easton, for outstanding aerial achievement in operational flight, the War Department announced yesterday.

Baity, a son of Capt. Baity of the Volunteers of America, enlisted when 19 years old. He

had been employed at the South Side pretzel plant. Capt. Baity now is in Wilmington, Del.

Information about Sergeant Baity was supplied yesterday by Charles Russ, a merchant at 227 S. 4th Street. Baity was indignant over the Pearl Harbor attack, Russ explained, and quickly overcame parental objections in order to enlist in the Army Air Corps.

"A fine, clean boy," said Mr. Russ, "and I am not surprised he has won a medal."
