Thomas Chovan, son of Andrew Chovan, 422 Cherokee Street, when he returned to his base on one of the Hawaiian Islands after participating in the conquest of Tinian and Saipan. It was a treat, according to the letter he wrote home to relatives.

Cpl. Chovan reported that he brought nothing with him when he returned to his base, having lost all his personal possessions and having no desire for souvenirs.

"All I want out of this war is a blunt recollection," he said.

In regard to the end of the war he said:

"The war news seems to be good, but it isn't over yet, not here anyway."
