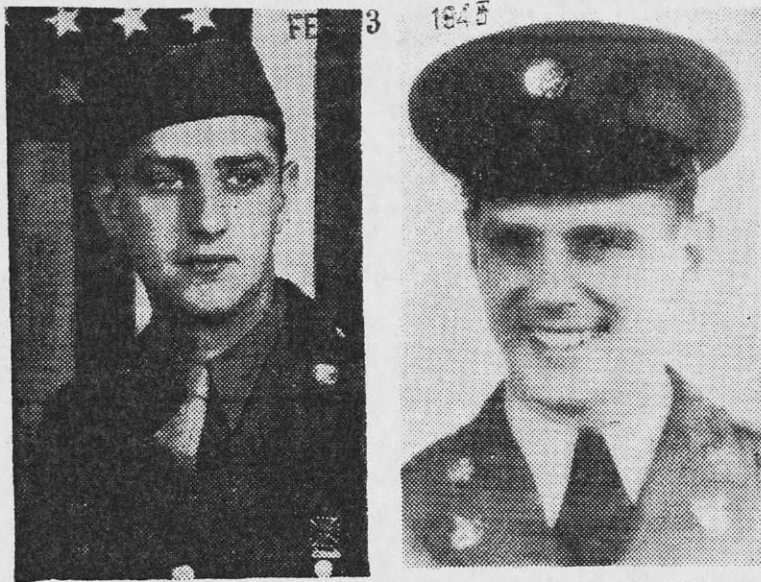


Bognar, William

Mrs. Mary Bognar, 1401 East Third Street, received word of the promotion of her two sons, William and Geza, both serving overseas with the infantry. William Bognar, presently stationed in Burma, has been promoted to Corporal. He has served in the U. S. Army for the past two years and has been stationed in Burma for 19 months. Geza Bognar, now a Staff Sergeant, is stationed somewhere in Germany with the 10th Armored Division that was given a commendation by Major General W. H. Morris Jr. for "having liberated 100 square miles of France and for occupying 50 square miles of German territory" on December 3. His group was also congratulated by Patton for having helped to capture Metz November 24. Both boys attended St. Joseph's Parochial School and were employed by the Bethlehem Steel Company before entering the service.
