Pfc. Robert G. Knauss, 20-year-old son of Mrs. Ellen Knauss of 807 Main Street, was injured in action on February 5, while participating in the Battle of Manila, according to an official telegram received by his mother. Inducted into the armed forces on March 26, 1943, he received his basic training at Ft. Leonard Wood, Missouri, and has been overseas for 18 months, assigned to an infantry unit. He was awarded the combat infantryman badge for outstanding service during the Bougainville campaign. He is a former employe of the Lambert Distributing Company.
