

83 Selectees Accepted For Military Service

Of the contingent of selectees sent to the Allentown Induction Center Tuesday by Local Draft Board No. 1, 64 were accepted for service in the Army, five for the Marine Corps and 14 for the Navy.

Five members of the R. O. T. C. at Lehigh University were also accepted for service. Included in this group were Bernard Deehan, last year's varsity football captain, and Edward J. Cavanaugh, a varsity lineman. The latter joined the naval forces.

Deehan, together with fellow R. O. T. C. members, including Louis F. Dellwig, Herbert O. Schutt and Donald G. Sanders, joined Uncle Sam's Army.

Seven Negroes, part of the contingent, were accepted, six for the Army and one for the Navy. Those accepted for the Army will be sent to Camp George Meade. The Navy selectee will go to a training station somewhere in New York.

Other members of the group selected yesterday will be sent to Camp Cumberland. Those who entered the U. S. Marine Corps, will go to Parris Island.
