East Fifth Street. He was wounded in action in France August 8 of this year. He is now recuperating in an Army hospital somewhere in England.

Pvt. Zsilavec, a graduate of Liberty High School and a former employe of the Bethlehem Steel Company, was inducted November 16, 1943. He shipped overseas in June, 1944.

In a letter received by his parents last week, he stated that his wounds are healing and that he is progressing well in his recovery.
