Wounded in Action



Mr. and Mrs. William Lerch, Kreidersville, received a War Department telegram informing them that their oldest son, Private George E. Lerch, was wounded in action while fighting with the 7th Army and is now recuperating in a hospital in France. He observed his twenty-fourth birthday January 10. Pvt. Lerch entered the Army September, 1943, and trained at Fort Riley, Kans., and Camp Campbell, Ky., before going overseas in October of last year. Three brothers are also in the service, Pfc. John Lerch, somewhere in the Pacific; Cpl. Albert Lerch, on the Hawaiian Islands, and R. 3-c Russell Lerch, home on leave at present.
