The 19-year-old soldier, who is home on a furlough at present, told his mother of his recent advancement in rank upon his arrival here. He enlisted in April of 1942 and is at present stationed at Richmond, Va. Mrs. Weaver was the recipient of other happy news at Christmas time when another son, Herbert, 24, a corporal technician with an anti-aircraft unit now stationed "somewhere in Africa" wrote that he is well and safe. This was the first word the mother had from him in some time. The young man has been in the Army since 1939, when he enlisted in the National Guard.
