Gets Purple Heart**

S/Sgt. Paul Thomas Conrad, husband of the former Doris Hummel, of Bethlehem, and son of Mr. and Mrs. Lewis Conrad, 617 Jordan Street, Allentown, was wounded in action somewhere in Germany and has been awarded the Purple Heart. He is now back in action after recovering.

S/Sgt. Conrad went overseas in September, 1944, after receiving infantry training at Camp VanDorn, Miss., and Camp Maxey, Tex.

Three brothers and a brother-in-law are also in service. They are Joe Conrad, somewhere in France; Dick Conrad, Ft. Bragg, N. C.; Mark Conrad, Alabama, and John Mileander, somewhere in England.
