**Son Of Former
Local Woman Dies ^{APR} 1 1945
On German Front**

Pfc. Edward Maley, 20, son of Patrolman and Mrs. Thomas Maley, 221 West Nesquehoning Street, South Easton, was killed in action in Germany March 28, while serving with a paratrooper unit. His mother is the former Grace Gallagher, of Packer Avenue, this city.

The young soldier was a graduate of the Easton Catholic High school of the class of 1943. The survivors are his parents, two brothers, Petty Officer 2/C Poseph, in Puerto Rico, and Petty Officer 3/C Thomas, in the Pacific, and three sisters, Marion, Grace and Katherine, at home.
