Petty Officer 2/C Raymond Fleming, son of Mrs. Helen Fleming, 805 East Fourth Street, was awarded a commendation by the Captain of his ship for "freeing a fouled up screw under the ship by swimming under water at intervals over a six-hour period and cutting a line attached to the screw with a knife." He was awarded the commendation while serving aboard an L. C. I. in a Pacific harbor. In the service for the past four years, Petty Officer Fleming has seen 30 months active sea duty. He is a graduate of Bethlehem Technical High School and a former employe of the Bethlehem Steel Company.
