**Sgt. Donald N. Renner
In Shanghai Shortly
After City's Liberation**

HEADQUARTERS, CHINA AIR
SERVICE COMMAND, Shanghai—
Sgt. Donald N. Renner, 27, Bethle-
hem, was among the first group of
U. S. Army personnel to arrive in
newly-liberated Shanghai following
V-J Day. Sgt. Renner is in the per-
sonnel and training division of the
China Air Service Command head-
quarters.

Sgt. Renner, whose wife, Mrs.
Ruth A. Renner, and daughter, Pa-
tricia Ann, live on Route 3, Bethle-
hem, was employed as a payroll ac-
countant at Bethlehem Steel Com-
pany before he entered the Army
August 22, 1943. He has been over-
seas since October, 1944, and in
China since January, 1945. His
mother, Mrs. Mildred Renner, lives
in Easton.
