Memorial Services 14 1944
Held for Soldier
Who Died in Burma

Relatives and friends, a representative group of members of Herbert F. W. Johnson Post No. 379, American Legion, and members of the congregation of St. John's Windish Lutheran Church, attended a memorial service held on Sunday morning for the late Staff Sergeant Albert L. Malok, who died in a Japanese prison camp in Burma.

Rev. Dr. E. A. Stiegler officiated and preached an impressive sermon.

Sergeant Malok, son of Mr. and Mrs. John Malok, 1629 Riegel Street, Hellertown, had served in the U. S. Air Forces since January 16, 1938, and saw action in Hawaii before being sent to the eastern theatre of war.

Last July he was awarded the Silver Star for gallantry in action.
