Awarded Medal



Col. Harold Thomas, on leave as head of the Department of Education and director of the Summer Session, Lehigh University, has been awarded the medal of the Legion of Merit for outstanding service as commandant, North African Branch of the U. S. Armed Forces Institute, and as chief of the Education Section of the New York Branch, Information and Education Division, it was learned here today. **JAN 14 1946**

Presentation of the award will be made at the War Department in Washington upon the return of Colonel Thomas from the Far East where he is now on assignment. He has just completed a tour of Army education installations in the Philippines and has gone to Japan where he will inspect the educational organization there.

Following that assignment he will be sent to Korea to organize the Army education program for U. S. soldiers stationed in that country.
