Lt. Jay Young, Of Pen Argyl, Is Missing

Lt. Jay Young, 21-year-old son of Mr. and Mrs. Audre J. Young, of 313 West Applegate Avenue, Pen Argyl, and husband of the former Miss Irene Kellow, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Joseph B. Kellow, of East Applegate Avenue, Pen Argyl, pilot on a Liberator bomber, has been listed as "missing in action" according to a telegram received from the U. S. War Department.

The telegram lists Lt. Young as missing in action over Germany since Feb. 15.

Lt. Young, who enlisted in the U. S. Army Air Corps as a cadet, received his pilot's wings and commission at Lubbock Army Air Field, Texas, in July, 1944. He received his training at Strother Field, Kans.

Prior to induction, he was employed by the Ingersoll-Rand Company, Phillipsburg, N. J.

He is a graduate of the Pen Argyl High School where he played several seasons of varsity football, playing an end position, being a co-captain in his senior year.
