Mrs. Mary Marcon of 22 East Main Street, Pen Argyl, has received a telegram from the U. S. War Department, reporting that her 19-year-old son, Pfc. Frank Marcon, of the U. S. Army Infantry, was slightly injured in action in Germany on February 24. The Marcon family the day before receipt of the telegram from the War Department, received a letter from Pfc. Frank, in which he stated that he had been injured in action and at the time of the writing of the letter, was recuperating in France. He entered the U. S. Army service on June 10 last year. He went overseas in January of this year. He is a graduate of Pen Argyl High School, where he was full-back on the football team during his senior year. He also played basketball. Prior to entering the armed forces he was employed at the Bangor mill of Bangor Mills, Inc.
