Mrs. Anna Wiczena, 746 Laufer Avenue, received a telegram from the War Department informing her that her son, Pfc. John Wiczena, with the Infantry Division, was seriously wounded in action in France, August 8.

Pfc. Wiczena entered the service July 25, 1941, and received his basic training at Fort Bragg, N. C., later being transferred to Camp Wheeler, Ga., then to Fort Dix, N. J.

In January, 1942, he went overseas to Ireland and later saw service in England, North Africa, Tunisia, Sicily and France.

His mother recently received a V-mail letter from her son stating he was convalescing in a base hospital.
