Private Lester C. Knapp, son of William L. Knapp, 130½ Graham Court, was wounded in action somewhere in Belgium, according to reports received by the family January 12, 1945. He is a paratrooper serving with the glider infantry. Pvt. Knapp enlisted in the Army June, 1942, and trained at Fort Belvoir, Va., and Greenville, Pa., before going overseas. He has seen service in North Africa, Sardinia, Corsica, Italy and France. He is a member of St. Peter's Lutheran Church.
