**Pfc. William Daggett,  
Ex-War Prisoner, Gets  
Honorable Discharge**

Pfc. William Daggett, son of Mrs. Betty Malloy, 511 Sioux Street, was honorably discharged on Tuesday, at Camp Jay, N. Y. 1945

A member of the combat forces since February 1942, he was on foreign soil since October 16, of the same year. He participated in engagements in French Morocco, Tunisia, Sicily, Normandy and Northern France. He was a POW spending some time in one of the Nazi concentration camps.

He was awarded a Presidential citation, the combat infantry badge, and the ribbons of the African and European war theatres.
