Martins Creek Pilot Back From War Zone

First Lt. Humbert Lucketti, 22, Martins Creek, has arrived at Army Air Forces Redistribution Station No. 2, Miami Beach, for reassignment processing after completing a tour of duty outside the continental United States.

As a B-17 pilot, Lt. Lucketti flew 33 missions during 28 months in the European theater of operations, winning a Distinguished Flying Cross and the Air Medal with three Oak Leaf Clusters.

Son of Mr. and Mrs. Andrew Lucketti, he entered the Army September 1942. He graduated from Easton High School in 1940.
