Wounded in Italy



Pvt. Leon Goldberg, son of Mr. and Mrs. M. Goldberg, 527 Pine Street, has been reported wounded in action in Italy September 26 in a War Department telegram.

Inducted July 7, 1943, he received his basic training at Camp Croft, S. C. From there he was shipped to North Africa and on to Europe.

In one of his last letters home, Pvt. Goldberg told of how the servicemen overseas feel about the over-optimistic attitude of their people back in the States. Pvt. Goldberg stated, "It takes whole-hearted, unselfish co-operation of every person to bring this war to an end. It can't be done by striking, racial prejudice and when somebody wants a couple of extra cents for working an extra hour."

His brother, Pvt. William Goldberg is home at present and will report to Fort Benning, Ga., for paratrooper training upon completion of his furlough.
