Wounded In Chest
In German Action

Pvt. Frank Chouk, son of Mr. and Mrs. Lewis Chouk, 638 Hayes Street, this city, and husband of the former Mary Warrick of 330 East 19th Street, Northampton, was wounded in Germany on February 12, according to word received by relatives recently.

The young infantryman served with Patton's Third Army. He is now recuperating at a hospital in France and a recent report from the War Department stated his condition is satisfactory. He is suffering from wounds of the left chest. The Chouks are parents of a two-year-old daughter, Paula.

Pvt. Chouk entered the service January 26, 1944 and went overseas in November of the same year. He received his training at Camp Blanding, Fla., and Fort Meade, Md.
