**Capt. R. E. Deily
Enroute to States**

Capt. Raymond E. Deily, formerly an interne at St. Luke's Hospital, is on his way home after serving with the 11th Airborne, overseas since May, 1944.

Capt. Deily is a veteran of the New Guinea, Leyte and Luzon campaigns. He was inducted in July, 1943, and qualified as a paratrooper at Fort Benning, Ga., in Dec. 1943.

Awarded the Bronze Star for heroic achievement, during the action in the Philippines, Capt. Deily will also sport on his chest of his combat jacket, the Asiatic-Pacific ribbon with three battle stars, Philippine Liberation ribbon with two stars. The captain participated in two combat jumps, one in Leyte and the other in Luzon.
