### Earns Award



Cpl. Martin P. Csillag was awarded the Bronze Star Medal by direction of the President and under provisions of the U. S. Army Regulations for heroic achievements in connection with military operations against the enemy of the United States April 21, 1945, in Germany. Cpl. Csillag maneuvered himself into position in the face of fire from an S. S. trooper who had just killed a member of his squad, and succeeded in rescuing another comrade by killing a sniper.

Cpl. Csillag's wife, Grace, and their five-months-old son, Frederick, live at 162½ Columbia Street. He has been serving for 39 months, 18 of which were on active duty overseas.
