Csillag, Martin P.

Earns Award

Cpl. Martin P. Csillag was awarded the Bronze Star Med-al by direction of the Presi-dent and under provisions of the U. S. Army Regulations for heroic achievements in con-nection with military opera-tions against the enemy of the United States April 21, 1945, in Germany. Cpl. Csillag maneu-vered himself into position in the face of fire from an S. S. trooper who had just killed a member of his squad, and suc-ceeded in rescuing another comrade by killing a sniper. Cpl. Csillag's wife, Grace, and their five-months-old son, Frederick, live at 162½ Colum-bia Street. He has been serv-ing for 39 months, 18 of which were on active duty overseas.
